The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH), Toronto, Ontario, is inviting applications for the position of Chief, Forensic Division.

CAMH is Canada's largest academic health science center dedicated to mental health and addictions and is fully affiliated with the University of Toronto. The Forensic Division, Complex Care and Recovery Program, supports inpatient and outpatient services for individuals at the intersection of law and mental health. The successful candidate will lead a team of exceptional clinicians, teachers and researchers, pursuing research in neuroscience, clinical and health service interventions, and epidemiology.

The ideal candidate will be dedicated to excellence in clinical care, teaching and research and to recruiting and developing the next generation of clinicians, teachers, and researchers. He or she will have demonstrated leadership skills and experience working in complex organizations. He or she will lead a Division with significant existing resources, including internal and external funding. The Chief will be a key member of both the clinical and academic leadership teams at CAMH, working collaboratively to ensure the successful integration of clinical care, teaching and research into all aspects of the organization. He or she will represent CAMH at local, provincial, and national tables on all matters related to forensic psychiatry. He or she will work collaboratively with other organizations in the greater Toronto region and Ontario.

The candidate should be an academic psychiatrist with exceptional clinical and research leadership skills in Forensic Psychiatry. He or she would be expected to be eligible for an appointment at the rank of Associate or Full Professor at the University of Toronto. CAMH is strongly committed to diversity and especially welcomes applications from visible minority group members, women, Aboriginal persons, persons with disabilities, members of sexual minority groups, and others who may contribute to the further diversification of ideas.
